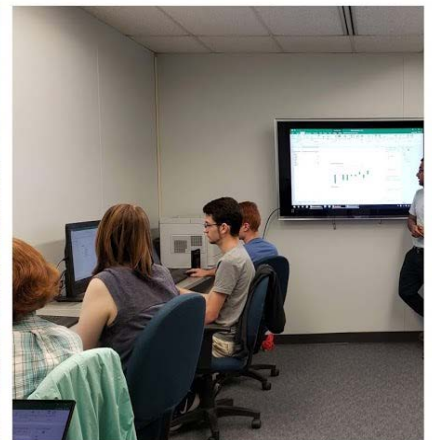


Summer 2022 internships in plant health at Kansas State University

Paid 8-week summer (1 June - 28 July 2022) research and extension internships are available in several departments at Kansas State University. The participants will get real world experience in plant health related projects in addition to professional development necessary for graduate school and today's workplaces.

- Gain research experience in laboratory, greenhouse, and field settings
- Learn about how universities support agriculture through extension education to growers/farmers
- Bolster your knowledge about how cutting-edge data science is used in agriculture
- Enhance your science communication skills
- Boost your understanding of how to succeed in graduate school
- Experience multiple field trips to different agricultural production systems



Stipend: \$5,200 (8 week) along with Free Housing and a Travel allowance

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 10 February 2022

Eligibility: undergraduate students with at least 3 semesters of coursework.
