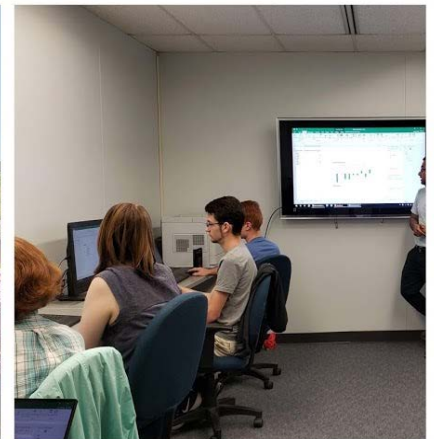


Summer 2023 internships in plant health at Kansas State University

Paid two month summer (31 May - 28 July 2023) research internships focused on plant health are available Kansas State University. The program includes mentoring faculty in several departments. The participants will engage in real world experience in plant health related projects in addition to professional development necessary for graduate school and today's workplaces.

- Gain research experience in laboratory, greenhouse, and field settings
- Learn about how universities support agriculture through extension education to growers/farmers
- Bolster your knowledge about how cutting-edge data science is used in agriculture
- Enhance your science communication skills
- Boost your understanding of how to succeed in graduate school
- Experience multiple field trips to different agricultural production systems



Stipend: \$5,350 along with free housing/dining and a travel allowance

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 15 February 2023

Eligibility: undergraduate students with at least 2 semesters of coursework.
